# 2022 SHPE National Convention



At the beginning of November, our club got the opportunity to attend the SHPE National Convention. SHPE National Convention (also known as Nationals) is the biggest gathering of Hispanics in STEM in the USA. This event is hosted by the SHPE (Society of Hispanic Professional Engineers) Organization and is focused on providing learning, professional development, and work experience opportunities. Throughout the duration of Nationals, companies such as Boeing, Cummins, Raytheon, and many more offer workshops and seminars on leadership, self-awareness, and self-development skills. This convention also offers a 2-day career Expo with 200+ STEM companies wanting to hire specifically us. They are there to meet, interview and offer an opportunity to the best of the best. We are the best of the best.


After 4 days of networking, putting ourselves out of our comfort zone, and hard work, our members have earned interviews with companies such as NASA, Northrop Grumman, American Airlines, Honeywell, and more. Our members have collectively gone through 110 interviews with more than 20 companies. Around 70% of our members have achieved what they went there to achieve, may it be networking, graduate school information, or an offer. More than half of our members have earned internship, co-op, and full-time offers. Some such as Isabella Novo and Nadia Meyer have walked away with offers from 4 different companies each.

This convention has not only allowed our chapter to grow professionally, but also develop stronger bonds between each other. We are now a stronger Familia who is ready to work even harder on helping each other be better. It also gave us the opportunity to reconnect with our alumni, whom most of us haven't even met. Those alumni are now working for amazing companies and were able to help the new generation navigate and succeed at Nationals.

At the end of our convention, two of our members received awards called "Para La Familia" which means "For the Family". Maximus Mendez and Alexa Duarte have been two out of five recipients out of hundreds of students to be recognized for their dedication and hard work. We appreciate their consistent dedication to the club and we couldn't be more proud of their accomplishments.



### **Summary**

As the semester progressed, our team was able to have a better estimate of how many students could attend nationals. Due to financial and scheduling limitations of our members, we estimated 40 students could attend nationals. This allowed us to downsize our initial plan from 48 students to 40 students. We decided that due to funding limitations, SHPE ERAU would only cover registration tickets and \$70 per person for their hotel expenses. The hotel expenses per person were only \$30 per night if they stayed in a 4-person room (\$120 total for hotel expenses).

Transportation was left to the individual to cover, but as a chapter, we helped organize carpooling groups that would drive to Charlotte and carpool to the airport. The safety of each and every member was ensured. As an executive board, we ensured people made it to their destination safely, everyone traveled in pairs, and reached out frequently to those carpooling on the highway.

Because of the College of Engineering's generous donation, we were able to allocate funds from the SGA to cover some of the hotel expenses. We properly reserved the COE's donation amount for registration tickets. However, at the time when the finances came into our Group Funds, we had paid for the registration tickets. We paid for them to ensure we could secure the cheaper Early-Bird rate which we had a deadline. The funds from the COE's donation paid for the hotel room expenses, but we ensured the value was the same as the value allocated for registration tickets.
